"I have always been attracted to people of the same gender even at a very young age and I did not understand why. I felt pain and hurt each time I am rejected by the people I fall in love with. I have often questioned "Why am I different and why do I have this orientation? Who can I tell about my struggles? Does God really care about me or even love me, and can I have victories over my struggles?"

I decided to join the support group at CLM to find answers and it's been 6 years now. What I have found is a clear understanding of what my root problems are, why I tick the way I do. As a result, I feel more confident about myself and also found love, understanding and acceptance by those whom I have journeyed with"

"I have tried suppressing my sexual orientation and just drowned myself in God and church and "godly" people. I was unhappy and disappointed. I tried to ignore God and sought to live a "normal" life with a man. I felt empty and there was a void deep in my heart that I knew no person could fill. Neither option worked.

The counselling and journeying group of "New Beginnings" helped a lot. In the group, I met people with similar struggles and I knew I was not alone & that gave me great comfort and hope. I've learnt and am learning a lot about myself and God and am grateful for the safe place to grow and mature into the man God wants me to be"

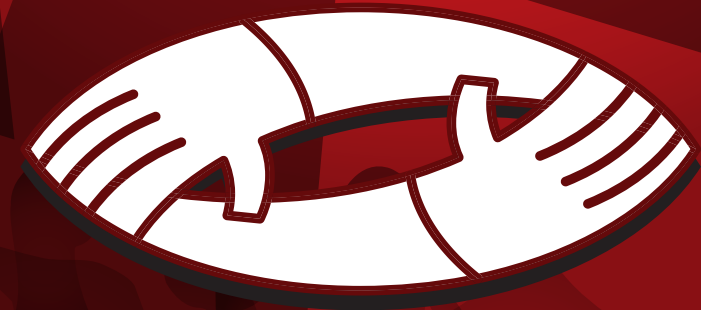

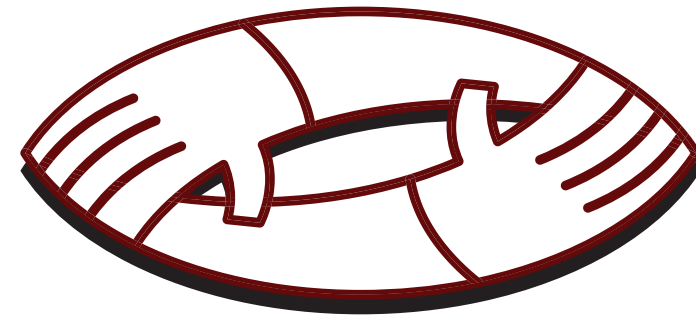

New Beginnings (NB) Support Group

NB is a facilitated group set up by CLM in 2006 to help those who are self-motivated and want to resolve their same gender attraction struggles. We offer to journey with them as they work through their issues by creating a safe and cohesive environment which is fundamental to the therapeutic effect for the journey of recovery. In this setting, members work to establish a level of trust that allows them to express and experience the emotions as they arise which are often difficult to express outside of group. The group's dynamics form the basis of the group's process and progress. Members learn from each other through honest feedback, expressions, awareness and acceptance of feelings.
